All graduate students will be able to register for winter 2015 on 10/26.

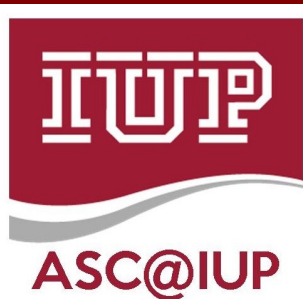
Alternate PINS will not be needed to register for winter 2015 courses.

Student Success Collaborative (SSC) Advisor Platform

Implementation of the Student Success Collaborative (SSC) ...positively impacting our students and faculty

The **Student Success Collaborative (SSC)** is a comprehensive approach to student success, providing the university community with the information that holds the potential to eventually help direct resources – advising, scheduling, career guidance – to faculty and students where it can make the greatest impact. The **SSC Advisor Platform** is a web-based tool that can assist advisors working with their advisees in a variety of situations, such as course registration and reviewing academic progress. Implemented using 10 years of IUP academic history so student success markers specific to IUP majors are optimized, the SSC Advisor Platform is provided by the Educational Advisory Board (EAB). Your input is valuable in making this initiative a success for our university.

Each issue of the Advisor Resources newsletter will include tips for using the SSC Advisor Platform. October Tips

A ribbon will appear at the top of a student's record in the Advisor Platform when they have mid-term grades posted. A quick glance will let you know if you need to review those grades when meeting with a student

Share a list that you have created with another user – copy the URL, paste it into an email message and hit send. If the person receiving the URL has access to the Advisor Platform they can open the saved list.

All Access, All the Time

Higher education is not an field that experience “slow seasons.” Just when it seems like faculty and staff have a moment to catch their breath the calendar page changes and it is time to begin thinking about advising appointments, intervening with a struggling student, and submitting grades.
